RANGE is the product of two classic Rhone varietals, each grown in vastly different locales - Grenache from the southern reaches of Washington State, and Syrah grown 100 miles to the north. The 2016 release is the first since 2012 anchored by a predominance of Grenache. Floral aromatics rush from the glass ahead of preserved fruit and dried petals. bound by a silky profile that is pervasive from sip to sip. The wine walks a fine line with brooding darkness, all the while it is incredibly lively. It is our most versatile offering.
